I have seeded you according to the seeding information provided and my experience. If you feel I have made a mistake please let me know and I will try to rectify it. But if you are a late entry or didn't provide any seeding information **Please Don't Complain** as its your own fault.

A. Blyton Village.

Please drive quietly through the village and observe the speed limit.

B. On Arrival.

On arrival at the venue, go to the Service Area to unload your car. There is not a specific trailer park, but please park your trailer sensibly. On the grass is fine but what EVER YOU DO

PLEASE DO NOT DAMAGE THE GRASS

Camping on site is available to £10 per crew payable at the burger van.

C. Permit No.

E. Yellow Flag Procedure.

A Yellow Flag procedure will operate on all stages. Competitors must use the procedure detailed in R25.6.4 & R25.6.5.

F. Scrutineering & Documentation.

The noise test will be carried out before the first stage not before scrutineering.

The locations of Scrutineering and Documentation are shown on the enclosed diagram.

Scrutineering and documentation times have been amended and are as below:

Fri 9th Feb 2018 16:30 – 19:30

Sat 10th Feb 2018 06:30 – 08:30

You should attend the scrutineering session that you have nominated on your entry form.

Competitors may freely attend the Friday evening session between the opening times.

Any competitor found on any part of the stage in a vehicle without the clerk of course's permission will be liable to exclusion.

G. Start Times & Classes.

A list of Start times will be on the official notice board as soon as possible after Documentation is closed. 1st car will start at 9.00.

We have no viable entry in Class 0 this will be merged with Class 1.

H. Process Cards & Numbers.

Process Cards will be available at Scrutineering. Door numbers will be on sale at Signing on.

I. Service Area.

The location of the Service Area is shown on the enclosed diagram. Whilst there is ample space in the Service Area please be considerate to other competitors. Ground sheets must be provided by the competitor for any work carried out in the Service Area. Competitors must not leave any litter in the Service Area. A bin bag will be provided at Documentation. Please take it home with you.

J. Petrol & Refuelling.

Re-fuelling within the Main Service Area will only be allowed while no other person is working on the competing car & in accordance with MSA Health & Safety regulations. There are no petrol stations close to the Service Area, and you are advised to bring enough fuel with you for the day (Approximately 40 Stage miles.)

K. Water Barriers, Barrels & Cones

There will be a number of Water Barriers and Barrels marking the course a large number of these will have water in them so please avoid hitting them. Any water barriers damaged will be charged to the competitor damaging them at £38.00 each. Cones are becoming our biggest cost on the event. Please avoid hitting them Ian Madison provides excellent video evidence of those flattening them I will be passing on the cost of the damage you do!
