Thank you for your entry to the Hall Trophy rally 2024 Please Read these Finals in conjunction with the SRs. A seeded entry list and road book are available on the website please print them and bring them with you, also on the diagrams you will see the Location of the Trailer Park, Service Area and Rally HQ. Space is limited and please only have the rally car & service vehicle and one other car , priority will be the Rally Car and Service vehicle in the service area . Other Vehicles may be asked to Park in another area at the owners risk ..

The gates at Weeton will be open Saturday 14:00 – 20:00 prompt and Sunday 06:00 until end, vehicles can be left overnight but at owner's risk. **No Overnight Camping.**

Please note when you approach the venue you do so within the speed limit and quietly as you go through any residential areas.

From the M55 J3 take the A585 then B5269 towards singleton / Weeton Barracks next junction take a Left turn onto B5260 then Weeton Camp entrance is on your Right.
Please drive quietly through the village and observe the speed limit.

Entrance is via **W3W stability.boat.obligated**

Follow arrows once at the venue, go to the Service Area to unload your car. Remove your Trailer and park it sensibly in the Trailer Park..

Please Note all Personnel must be within the venue by 07.45 Latest .

Spare Wheels

There is no requirement for people to run with a spare wheel in the car. But competing crews will be liable for the full repair cost for damaging the surface if they run a long way on a puncture.

Comp Numbers

Numbers will be on sale at Scrutineering, these must be fitted to both front doors of the car.

Service Area

The location of the Service Area and Trailer Park is shown on the diagrams you have printed off. Whilst there is ample space in the Service Area please be considerate to other competitors when You park your vehicles and Trailers .

Speed within the service area must be Kept to 5mph Please adhere to this

Ground sheets must be provided by the competitor for any work carried out in the Service Area. Competitors must not leave any litter in the Service Area. A bin bag will be provided at documentation. Please take all waste home with you.

Refuelling

The Service Area is a designated refuelling zone and as such will be classed as a **NO SMOKING ZONE** All fuel must be pumped, there will be NO open pouring. Refuelling will only be allowed while **no other person is working on or seated in the competing car** & in accordance with Motorsport UK Health & Safety regulations.

Please ensure you have a fire extinguisher on hand.

Any crew or any member of your service crew caught smoking could lead to penalties being applied up to and including exclusion. Remember you are responsible for the behaviour of your service crew at all times.

Competitors Briefing.

There will be a mandatory competitor briefing outside Rally HQ at 08:40hrs prompt where you will be given your time cards. If you do not attend you will not get your time cards.

Venue

Please Respect the venue we are guests here , Cutting will not be tolerated , Also please adhere to the route, deviating from the route and striking the Stage furniture could lead to penalties being applied . we would like to come back in the future so please respect the venue

Start Times.

A list of start times will be available at Rally HQ from approx. 08:10hrs on Sunday. Car 1 should be at SSA1 at 08.57 and will start the stage at 09.00 and cars will follow at 30 second intervals.

Awards.

Awards Presentation will be as soon as possible after the results go final.

Class 4 has been amalgamated into class 5 as per section 12 of the SRs "The minimum for each class is 5 should that not be reached the organisers have the right to Cancel the event or amalgamate the classes as necessary"
